Teaching is going online! How nice to be able to create a small quilted piece in the comfort of your home, with all your materials and tools at hand! No long journeys nor carrying heavy sewing machines....

The workshops will be conducted via Zoom. There will be pre-workshop instructions regarding requirements and a little advance preparation. On the day, there will be two sessions, with a long break in the middle. A short extra session may be arranged for a little later to see work in progress, answer questions and tie up loose ends.

There is also the possibility of arranging the workshop over two or three weeks, on a half-day a week basis. Detailed arrangements will be discussed as required.

COLOURSCAPES

(available from October)

Villages, towns, fields, the sea, surround us with colour and makes us feel happy. Either a cityscape or a village by the sea can be created in this workshop, using a very easy fused collage technique. Sewing machine only needed for quilting after the class.






IMAGINING MAPS

(available from November)

Maps are fascinating and help us to understand the world. We will create a piece representing an English village on green fields, using an improvisational cutting and piecing technique. Sewing machine required during the class for piecing; quilting will be done after the workshop.



IMPROVISATIONAL PIECING

(available from November)

Improvisational patchwork is a very satisfying and fun way of working: no rulers, and few rules. We will focus on techniques of freehand cutting, gently curved and 'off the straight' seams, and fine line piecing. Each participant will construct their own personal improvisational top, playing with line, shape and colour. Sewing machine required during the class for piecing; quilting will be done after the workshop.



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
