Workshops will be conducted via Zoom. There will be pre-workshop instructions regarding requirements and a little advance preparation. On the day, there will be one session of two and a half hours.

Mosaic ColourScapes

These are small colourful pieces around 9" by 13" (23 by 33 cm), although they can be made bigger or smaller. An impression of exotic buildings is achieved with colourful shapes in mosaic style, using an easy fused collage technique. Sewing machine required for quilting.



Quirky Townscapes

Invent a new world! Using an easy fusing technique, create buildings with curved walls, pointy and crooked roofs, randomly placed doors and windows, and variations in decoration and quilting. Combine solid and batik fabrics. After quilting it can be finished with fabric edges or placed in a card mount.



Map Fragments

These small map 'fragments' are made with an easy fusing technique. They can be made in different colours. Daytime ones represent the English countryside, with a variety of green fields. The night-time ones are made using dark blues, sometimes purples. Harvest-time fields can be represented with orange and yellow. They can be framed with a white card mount.
